

1.0 GENERAL

The Happy Homestead Cemetery District provides interment services, opening and closing services, and sells such products as concrete vaults or liners, cremains caskets, vases, niches and so forth. In order to maintain control of District resources, the District has determined that payments for such services and products will not be accept in cash.

2.0 DEFINITIONS

2.1 "District" shall mean the Happy Homestead Cemetery District.

2.2 "Cemetery" shall mean the Happy Homestead Cemetery.

2.3 "Manager" shall mean the District Manager of the Happy Homestead Cemetery District.

2.4 "Cash" shall mean currency in any form.

2.5 "Check" shall mean a draft drawn on an open and active account held in a bank, credit union, money market account or brokerage which account contains and shall continue to contain sufficient funds to cover the amount of the draft issued to the District.

2.6 "Cashiers Check" shall mean a draft issued and guaranteed by a bank or credit union and payable to the District.

2.7 "Money Order" shall mean a draft issued by an agency such as the U.S. Post Office, Western Union, etc. payable to the District and immediately negotiable by the District upon receipt.

3.0 POLICY

3.1 The District will accept only Checks, Cashier's Checks or Money Orders in payment for services and products. All such Checks, Cashier's Checks and Money Orders must be

negotiated and cleared prior to any interment services being provided.

3.2 The District will not accept Cash in payment for any services or products.

3.3 The District will not accept Travelers Checks in payment for any services or products.

3.4 All services and products, including but not limited to contributions to the Endowment Care Fund, must be paid in full before any such services or products will be provided to the family or purchaser.
